MEALS

Breakfast: Fruit, Cereals, Fresh juices, Yoghurt, Full English breakfast (eggs, bacon, sausages, tomatoes) cheese if required, pancakes to order, bread, toast. Coffee, tea, herbal tea
Breakfast can be served at any time in the house and or lodge. Picnic breakfasts can also be arranged
Lunch: is served between 1:00-2:00 pm unless otherwise arranged. We also have picnic lunches on some days. Lunch is usually a cold buffet, with a variety of dishes i.e. meat/chicken, salads, breads, cheeses, crackers, and dessert.

Dinner: is served at about 08:00 pm depending on guests wishes.

Dinner is 3 courses. Appetizer, main dish, dessert, and coffee/tea/herbal tea.

Meals are varied according to guests wishes, private dinners on Verandahs and other places can be arranged. All special dietary & allergies need to be organized with us in advanced.

OI Malo House Info

- 5 mins from OL Malo airstrip
- 40 mins from Loisaba airstrip – transfers to Loisaba/Sabuk are charged – same as OI Malo Lodge
- Generator power – run morning and evenings and an inverter so bedside lights can be used at night
- Can charge phone/camera batteries in rooms
- Hair dryers available for guest use
- Intermittent Mobile network
- Internet access at pool area
- No kids age limit
- MEALS: As per lodge above.

General Info

Wheel chair access:

Lodge – Room no.1 has full access for a wheelchair, the dining room and most of the pool area is accessible.

House – Giraffe room is wheel chair friendly, the whole pool area, sitting and dining room are accessible.

Riding information – OI Malo

Horse info: 24 horses / ponies

13hh – 15hh Tbs/ TB crosses & Small, somali type horses/ponies - strong and good for trekking.

Weight limit: 85kg for beginners, will take heavier experienced riders on request.

Type of Riding: Horses are schooled to **English** trail riding - no show jumping but those capable can jump logs on the way where available. Horses are used to going amongst the wildlife. Arena also available for riding in.

Level of riding: All level of riders can be provided for. Children can be accommodated for.

Type of saddles: mainly English saddles - some Western & Gaucho saddles available on request.

Equipment at lodge: Riding hats, riding half chaps

Game seen on rides: Giraffe, zebra, gazelles, eland, kudu, oryx, occasional cat, elephant at some time of year etc.

Riding Safaris: We do mobile camping riding safaris with OI Malo Nomad.

1 night sleeping out options from lodge/House.

These can be organized whilst people are here as you hold your room at the lodge.

1. Treehouse: is a platform in a tree, it has space for 2 people, or a family with 2 small kids. We make up beds on the floor of the platform and people can sit up and look out over the waterhole with a spotlight. You eat a simple packed meal and are left with a radio to call camp if they need. A long drop is set up at the base of the tree. No roof on the tree house – so we cant use it if it's raining.

2. The Leopard Hide: is a banda at the foot of the cliffs below the lodge. It is perched on a rock with a view over the waterhole. It has a roof and 4 bunk beds with low wall at the front to sit and look out. The area is enclosed at the back by a rock wall and there is a loo and shower. Packed meal for supper and fresh hot morning drinks brought down from the lodge. Guests are left with a radio if they need to call anyone.

3. Fly camping:

NB – ONLY AVAILABLE IF OL MALO NOMAD NOT IN OPERATION & WITH ADVANCE WARNING Tents set up on the river or near water. Same tents as Nomad, open to the stars with a fly sheet in case it rains. You eat on your laps under the stars around a campfire. Tents have camp beds and bedrolls. Long drop, bucket showers (unless people camping on the river and just want to swim in the evening.

Game drives – day & night,

Horseback riding

Camel riding,

Guided walks looking at animals, insects & medicinal plants,

Ranch life visits (milking, eggs collecting, veggies garden visits etc)

Mountain biking,

Running with a warrior (& the 3 peak challenge!!)

Samburu school, workshop & Cultural visits,

Market trips on market days,

Bush breakfasts (which we keep a surprise for guests)

River lunches & tubing when the water is high enough,

River / dam fishing

No Kids age limit

No 'Kids club' as such but masses for them to get up to, they can do all of the above and our guides are great at taking them off to do things if the parents want a break.

For Example: making bows and arrows, walking to school with the Samburu kids, milking the cows, going on 'dudu' walks, being beaded by the mamas in the workshop.

However - Parents must be in charge at all times if children are swimming or near the pool.
