As the gateway to East Africa, this dynamic city is more than just a stopover, it's a destination in its own right. From its leafy suburbs and vibrant cultural institutions to nearby wilderness teeming with wildlife, Nairobi invites guests to explore at their own pace and uncover its many layers.





The Sheldrick Wildlife Trust is a renowned sanctuary for orphaned elephants, where guests can learn about the rehabilitation process and see the exceptional care these animals receive. The public feeding and mud bath session takes place daily at 11:00 am, a memorable opportunity to see the elephants up close.

GIRAFFE CENTRE

Feed endangered Rothschild giraffes by hand and learn about this remarkable species at this peaceful sanctuary.

FLOWER FARM VISIT Karen Roses

Located on Ngong View Road, Karen Roses is a family-run flower farm producing worldclass roses. Enjoy a guided walk through the greenhouses and learn about sustainable floriculture. Tours are available by appointment and can be arranged through our

concierge team.

KAREN BLIXEN MUSEUM

Once home to the author of Out of Africa, this charming colonial house offers insights into Kenya's history and Blixen's extraordinary life.

NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK

Spot lions, rhinos and giraffes against a city skyline in this rare capital city wildlife park, just a short drive from Hemingways.

A sophisticated and interactive experience for spirit enthusiasts. Guests are guided through a gin tasting featuring locally distilled botanicals before blending their own signature Kenyan gin to take home.

KARURA FOREST Gigiri/Muthaiga

A shaded green space perfect for walks, picnics, or cycling. Enjoy waterfalls, wildlife, and forest serenity just minutes from the city.

LIMURU TEA TOUR Limuru Highlands

Spend a peaceful morning exploring tea fields. Learn about the growing process and enjoy a tea tasting with views of the rolling highlands.

NAIROBI RAILWAY MUSEUM CBD

Delve into Kenya's railway history with restored colonial-era locomotives, interactive exhibits, and fascinating stories.

NATIONAL MUSEUM OF KENYA Museum Hill

Explore exhibits on Kenyan history, art, palaeontology, and wildlife in this elegant and thoughtfully curated space.

Held every Saturday, this open-air market offers organic produce, cheeses, baked goods, free-range eggs, and artisanal products in a leafy, social setting.

A renowned workshop and social enterprise where women artisans craft hand painted ceramic beads and pottery. Guests can tour the factory to watch the bead making process and shop a wide range of vibrant, fair trade jewellery. A meaningful stop for those interested in ethical fashion and local craftsmanship.

UTAMADUNI CRAFT CENTRE

A charming house turned market space, featuring African crafts, jewellery, homeware and textiles from various local artisans.

NATURE, CONSERVATION & FOREST DINING

EARLY MORNING

Start the day early with a game drive at Nairobi National Park (Karen), one of the few capital cities in the world with a wildlife park on its doorstep.

LATE MORNING

Visit the David Sheldrick Wildlife Trust (Karen) at 11:00 am for the elephant orphanage's public feeding session.

LUNCH

Head to Ololo Safari Lodge & Farm (Nairobi National Park) for a slow, organic lunch overlooking the plains.

AFTERNOON

Visit the Giraffe Centre (Karen) for an up-close encounter with endangered Rothschild giraffes, followed by a stop at the historic Karen Blixen Museum (Karen).

DINNER

End the day with an elegant meal at The Deck at Hemingways Eden (Karen).

MORNING

Visit the National Museum of Kenya (Museum Hill) followed by the nearby Nairobi Railway Museum (CBD).

MIDDAY

Join a Graffiti Tour (CBD) led by local street artists, exploring murals and Nairobi's urban creative culture.

LUNCH

Head to Bang Bang Thai Kitchen (Village Market, Gigiri) for a bold, flavourful break.

AFTERNOON

Walk through Village Market (Gigiri), stop by Circle Art Gallery (Lavington), and if time allows, enjoy a relaxed visit to The Artisanal Gallery at Hemingways Eden (Karen).

DINNER

Book a table at Cultiva (Karen) for a farm-to-table experience in a tranquil, open-air garden setting with Latin American flair.


