NYAMATA GENOCIDE MEMORIAL & RECONCILIATION TRIP


Bugesera District, ±40 mins from Kigali

The Nyamata Memorial, set within a former church where over 10,000 people were killed during the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi, offers a powerful space for remembrance and education. Preserved clothing, artefacts and personal stories honour the victims, while survivor testimony provides a deeply moving perspective. The visit continues into the Bugesera community, where you'll meet local entrepreneurs and learn how reconciliation and resilience are shaping Rwanda's future.

GORILLA TREKKING BY HELICOPTER Volcanoes National Park, on request

Skip the drive and soar over Rwanda's rolling hills on a private helicopter transfer to Volcanoes National Park. Arrive at the park gates refreshed and ready for one of the world's most moving wildlife encounters, trekking to see the mountain gorillas.

A family-friendly introduction to local life, with cooking, weaving, and storytelling elements.

Visit to Kigali Public Library or Children's Book Initiative pop-ups, perfect for quiet time and culturally themed reading.

HANDS-ON ART WORKSHOPS AT INEMA ARTS CENTRE

Children can create their own pieces alongside resident artists.

AFTERNOON SWIM

Enjoy an afternoon swim at the hotel pool, with time to relax and enjoy poolside refreshments.

Gentle strolls through the memorial gardens, offering space for calm reflection (more suitable for older children when guided appropriately).

CULTURE & CREATIVITY

MORNING

Begin with a Kigali Graffiti Tour, exploring colourful street art in the CBD and Nyamirambo. Local guides share the stories behind the murals and the artists driving Rwanda's creative movement.

LATE MORNING

Continue to Inema Arts Centre and a nearby gallery in Kacyiru, where contemporary Rwandan artists showcase vibrant paintings, sculptures and mixed-media works.

LUNCH

Stop at Heaven Restaurant in leafy Kiyovu, known for its fresh, sustainable cuisine and garden setting.

DINNER

Return to Hemingways Retreat Kigali for a refined evening at Fusion, where global flavours meet Rwandan ingredients in a tranquil garden setting.

AFTERNOON

Discover Kigali's fashion scene with a guided Fashion & Fabric Tour, visiting boutiques, ateliers and the tailoring studio at Hemingways Retreat Kigali to see craftsmanship in action.

DAY 2

NATURE & HISTORY

MORNING

Take a guided walk through Nyandungu Eco Park, a restored wetland sanctuary that showcases Rwanda's commitment to conservation and biodiversity.

LATE MORNING

Visit Umusambi Village in Kacyiru, home to over 50 rescued Grey Crowned Cranes and a haven for bird lovers. Boardwalks and nature trails wind through the reserve, offering a peaceful setting for photography and quiet reflection.

LUNCH

Dine at Nyurah in the city centre, an elegant restaurant where international flavours meet Rwandan influence in a refined setting.

AFTERNOON

Travel to Nyamata Genocide Memorial & Reconciliation Centre in Bugesera (about 40 minutes from Kigali). This profoundly moving visit includes testimony from survivors and an introduction to community projects that symbolise Rwanda's resilience.

DINNER

Dine at Poivre Noir in Kacyiru, celebrated for its inventive European cuisine and elegant yet relaxed atmosphere.



CULINARY & COFFEE EXPERIENCES

MORNING

Begin with a guided market tour in Nyamirambo, meeting vendors and learning about local ingredients before heading to Heaven Restaurant for a hands-on cooking class.

LUNCH

Enjoy the dishes you've prepared, paired with a cocktail or fresh juice in Heaven's tropical garden setting.

AFTERNOON

Venture just outside Kigali for a Coffee Masterclass with a local cooperative. From bean to brew, discover Rwanda's world-renowned coffee culture and savour tastings guided by expert baristas.

DINNER

End the day at Shokola Rooftop in Kacyiru, with panoramic views of Kigali's hills and a vibrant, social atmosphere.

DAY 4

WELLNESS & COMMUNITY

MORNING

Start with yoga or a workout on the deck at Hemingways Retreat Kigali, a calming space overlooking the city's rolling hills.

MIDDAY

Join the Banana Wine Experience at Heaven, learning the traditional process behind Rwanda's locally made fruit wines.

LUNCH

Casual dining at Java House in Kigali Heights or a nearby location, perfect for a light break between activities.

Visit The Opportunity Factory or a local artisan collective in Kiyovu, meeting designers and craftspeople whose work blends creativity with social impact.
